Julia Mayer, a teacher from Bundesgymnasium and Bundesrealgymnasium Enns in Austria, will talk to you about how to prepare students for discussing the Holocaust. During this webinar, we will explore the **free ready-to-use resources** available on the 'Hi-story Lessons' platform, such as the infographics, maps, various other sources of information, lesson plans and animations.

Julia Mayr teaches History and English at the Bundesgymnasium and Bundesrealgymnasium Enns. She is the regional coordinator in Upper Austria for *_erinnern.at_*, which develops educational materials in the field of Holocaust education and the prevention of antisemitism and racism. For years, she has dedicated her work to the remembrance of the Gusen concentration camp, its deportees and its commemoration at the memorial sites.
